Coach,

Thanks for playing in the 2016 Woodstock Summer Slam Baseball Tournament. This letter is part of an email that includes all the information you will need to participate including player roster, rules, policies and GPS field addresses. PLEASE attempt to find the answer to your questions in these documents before you email or call us. We really appreciate it. The schedule link and website will be emailed on or before June 3, 2016, when all teams have been finalized.

Here's the last few details:

A link to all schedules and scores will be posted on our website at: woodstockavalanche.atomicleagues.com. There will also be a link on our website to real-time game results (on or before June 3, 2016).

Please check-in at least 45 minutes prior to your first game at your first game location. A Summer Slam representative will be at each field. If you have not yet turned in your signed roster and Insurance Certificate, this will be required before you play your first game. A player may only be rostered on one team and must be listed on the roster sheet to be eligible to play.

After each game, each manager will be required to check-in and verify the final game score with the site supervisor and/or call the tournament director. The final game score will be recorded and reported on the website.

Game time limits will be as follows:

1:30 time limit	9U	6 innings for pool play games
1:45 time limit	9U	6 innings for playoffs
1:45 time limit	10U-12U	6 innings
1:45 time limit	13U-14U	7 innings
no time limit	9U-14U	Championship games only

Garbage cans: There are plenty of garbage cans around the fields. Please be sure to dispose of all your garbage and clean out your dugouts after each game. We appreciate it very much.

Coolers and food restricted to the parking lots only. Teams may bring a drink cooler in the dugout for use during the games. We will offer full concessions. There is NO grilling or open flame allowed on any of the fields, parking lots or game sites per city regulations.

After each pool play game, teams will shake hands and line up on the baselines. Each manager will present an MVP award to an outstanding player on the opposing team. These awards will be given to each manager at check-in.

At each Championship game, trophies and awards will be awarded to the first and second place teams.
