

Woodstock Summer Slam

2017 Tournament Policies June 9-11, 2017

The tournament director reserves the right to alter the tournament format in the event of inclement weather or other unplayable conditions or other events that may arise. The schedule is set up so games may simply be pushed back on the same fields in most cases.

1. Woodstock Summer Slam reserves the right to alter Tournament Rules with advance notice to teams.
2. Tournament game schedules will be posted on respective tournament page on the website at least by **5:00pm the Monday** before the start of the tournament, unless otherwise stated.
3. **Check-In With Site-Supervisor:** Not less than 45 minutes prior to your first game, each team must submit their roster sheet **signed by parents, players and the team manager**. Make a copy of the signed form and turn the copy in at check-in so you only need to get this signed once! Managers must also provide team's proof of insurance. Managers need to have a photocopy of player's birth certificate with them at check-in. Managers should have their birth certificates with them during the tournament in case of a roster protest.
4. No team shall be permitted to start tournament play without all information being completed at check-in. If your team fails to comply with our check-in procedures prior to the start of the first game, your game may be a forfeit.
6. **Rainout Info:** Weather Updates will be posted on website: woodstockavalanche.atomicleagues.com. The tournament schedule will be posted on **<http://woodstockavalanche.atomicleagues.com>**. Please check BEFORE contacting Tournament Director.
7. Game Scores and Current Standings - will be posted via a link on our website at <http://woodstockavalanche.atomicleagues.com>. We will do our best to update games real-time throughout the day via the game standings link that we will provide the week before the tournament.
8. There is no gate fee for our tournament. Spectators will not be charged on site admission. We will have full concessions available. **IMPORTANT: Please help us keep our parks clean! Put all trash in garbage cans! Clean your dugout and stands after each game.** No grills are allowed at any field, parking lot or game site per city regulation.
9. Use of tobacco and alcoholic products is prohibited on all fields, stands and in dugouts. No weapons are allowed on any city or park district property. Failure to comply will result in dismissal from park and possible team suspension from tournament with no refund. Games are hosted on park district property and local school property, so all local laws will be strictly enforced by local law enforcement.
10. Our tournaments have "zero tolerance" for any physical confrontations by players, coaches, fans or anyone else. Upon the first violation, the violating party may be removed from the facility for the remainder of the tournament.
11. Communication: Our On-Site Tournament Directors are in communication at all times. If there is an emergency or problem, please see the On-Site Director immediately. You will be given the tournament director's contact information on check-in.
12. **If an event is cancelled/shortened due to weather, the following policy will apply:**
 - 0 games started: Refund in the amount of entry fee, less a \$50 administrative fee, Will be mailed within two weeks.
 - 1 game started: Credit of 50% of entry fee less a \$50 administrative fee.
 - 2 games started: No refunds
